ORDER FOR SURRENDER

To: The Prosecutor of the International Tribunal

I, Patricia Wald, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal");

CONSIDERING United Nations Security Council Resolution 827 of 25 May 1993, and Articles 19(2) and 29 of the Statute of the International Tribunal ("Statute"), and Rules 54 to 61 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal ("Rules");

CONSIDERING the indictment submitted by the Prosecutor against **MOMČILO KRAJIŠNIK** on 21 February 2000 and confirmed by me, a Judge of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia, on 25 February 2000, a copy of which is annexed to this warrant of arrest;


HEREBY AUTHORISE the Prosecutor or her representatives to search for, arrest and surrender to the International Tribunal:

MOMČILO KRAJIŠNIK, son of Sreten and Milka (née Špirić) born on 20 January 1945 in Zabrđe, municipality of Novi Grad, Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina, former President of the Bosnian Serb Assembly, former member of the National Security Council, and former member of the Presidency of Republika Srpska;

Alleged to have committed in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina, between 1 July 1991 and 31 December 1992: Genocide, Crimes Against Humanity, Violations Of The Laws And Customs Of War, And Grave Breaches Of The Geneva Conventions, punishable under Articles 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7(1) and 7(3) of the Statute of the International Tribunal;

And to advise the said **MOMČILO KRAJIŠNIK** at the time of his arrest, and in a language he understands, of his rights as set forth in Article 21 of the Statute and, *mutatis mutandis*, in Rules 42 and 43 of the Rules which are annexed hereto, and of his right to remain silent, and to caution him that any statement he makes shall be recorded and may be used in evidence. The indictment and review of the indictment (and all other documents annexed to the present warrant) must also be brought to the attention of the accused.

REQUEST THAT The Prosecutor or her representatives, upon the arrest of **MOMČILO KRAJIŠNIK**, promptly notify the Registrar of the International Tribunal, pursuant to Rule 57, for the purposes of his transfer to the International Tribunal,
