BEING SEIZED of the Defence’s “Motion for Continuance of Provisional Release Hearing, filed on 12 May 2000 (the “Request for continuance”);


NOTING the Prosecutor’s letter dated 12 May 2000 in which the Prosecution does not oppose the Request for continuance;
