THIS TRIAL CHAMBER,

PURSUANT to Rule 81(D) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal,

ORDERS that, subject to any other Order of the Trial Chamber, the taking of photographs by two press photographers designated for this purpose at the beginning of all the hearings be authorised in accordance with the instructions of the Registry and, in particular, the Chief of Security from the Security Service of the Tribunal,

STATES that, subject to the security measures which the Registry considers it must take, the number of authorised photographers is set at three for the day of the initial appearance of the accused.
