**WARRANT OF ARREST
ORDER FOR SURRENDER**

To: The Prosecutor of the International Tribunal

I, Judge Liu Daqun, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

CONSIDERING United Nations Security Council Resolution 827 of 25 May 1993, and Articles 19(2) and 29 of the Statute of the International Tribunal (“Statute”), and Rules 54 to 61 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”);

CONSIDERING the indictment submitted by the Prosecutor against **DRAGAN OBRENOVIĆ** and confirmed by me, a Judge of the International Tribunal, on the ninth day of April 2001, a copy of which is annexed to this warrant of arrest;


HEREBY AUTHORISE the Prosecutor or her representatives to search for, arrest and surrender to the International Tribunal:

DRAGAN OBRENOVIĆ, son of Milomir, born 12 April 1963 in the Bosnian Serb village of Matino-Brdo (Rogatica), former Captain in the Armour and Mechanised Forces Branch of the JNA, former Chief of Staff/Deputy Commander of the 1st Zvornik Infantry Brigade (Zvornik Brigade), former Acting Commander of the Zvornik Brigade, former Acting Commander of the 303rd Motorised Brigade, and current Lieutenant Colonel and Commander of the 503rd Motorised Brigade in Zvornik;

Alleged to have committed in the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina, between 11 July 1995 and 1 November 1995, Complicity in Genocide, punishable under Articles 4(3)(e), 7(1) and 7(3) of the Statute of the Tribunal; Crimes Against Humanity, punishable under Articles 5(a), 5(b), 5(h), 7(1) and 7(3) of the Statute of the Tribunal; Violations of the Laws or Customs of War, punishable under Articles 3, 7(1) and 7(3) of the Statute of the Tribunal;

And to advise said **DRAGAN OBRENOVIĆ** at the time of his arrest, and in a language he understands, of his rights as set forth in Article 21 of the Statute and, *mutatis mutandis*, in Rules 42 and 43 of the Rules, which are annexed hereto, and of his right to remain silent, and to caution him that any statement he makes shall be recorded and may be used in evidence. The indictment and review of the indictment (and all other documents annexed to the present warrant) must also be brought to the attention of the accused.

REQUEST THAT the Prosecutor or her representatives, upon the arrest of **DRAGAN OBRENOVIĆ**, promptly notify the Registrar of the International Tribunal, pursuant to Rule 57, for the purposes of his transfer to the International Tribunal.
