**DECISION TO VACATE THE ORDER FOR NON-DISCLOSURE  
ENTERED 8 JUNE 2001**

---

I, Judge Fouad Riad, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

**BEING SEISED** of the “Motion of the Prosecutor to Vacate in full the Order for Non-Disclosure Entered on 8 June 2001”, filed on 26 July 2001;


**NOTING** the “Order on Review of the Indictment Pursuant to Article 19 of the Statute”, which ordered the non-disclosure of the indictment IT-01-45-I;

**HAVING HEARD** the Prosecutor on 26 July 2001;

**CONSIDERING** that a significant ground for the initial order of non-disclosure no longer exists for reasons provided by the Prosecutor;

**PURSUANT** to Rules 53 and 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;

**HEREBY ORDER** that the non-disclosure order of 8 June 2001 shall be vacated in full, with immediate effect.
