CONSIDERING that, pursuant to Rule 113 of the Rules, Zoran Vuković filed his brief in reply on 28 August 2001 and that Dragoljub Kunarac and Radomir Kovač filed theirs on 4 September 2001;

CONSIDERING that, at the request of the pre-trial Judge at the status conference of 16 October 2001, Defence Counsel must, before 9 November 2001, transmit to the senior legal officer of the Appeals Chamber a document setting out how the common grounds of appeal shall be divided amongst Defence Counsel and how much time each of them shall be allotted;
