**CORRIGENDUM TO THE "ORDER ON THE PROVISIONAL RELEASE
OF THE ACCUSED PAVLE STRUGAR"**

TRIAL CHAMBER I (“the Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1992 (“the Tribunal”):

NOTING the “Order on the Provisional Release of the Accused Pavle Strugar,” issued by the Trial Chamber on 30 November 2001 (“the Order”);

NOTING that there is a typographical error in condition 5 (h) in the disposition on page six of the Order, being one of the conditions with which the accused Pavle Strugar was ordered to comply during the term of his provisional release;


CONSIDERING that the phrase “...victims, witnesses of co-accused of the case,…” in condition 5(h) should read “...victims, witnesses or co-accused of the case,…”;

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS :

1. condition 5(h) in the disposition on page six of the Order should be replaced by the following :
“The accused shall not have any contact whatsoever nor in any way interfere with victims, witnesses or co-accused of the case, or obstruct justice in any way”;
2. the French translation of the Order, if not yet filed, should include the correction described above.
