I, Judge Hunt, Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

NOTING the “Order to File Amended Grounds of Appeal”, dated 18 February 2002, whereby the parties were ordered to file a document clearly and concisely listing each and every one of their respective grounds of appeal;

NOTING that Defence Counsel for Mario Čerkez and Dario Kordić stated during the Status Conference of 19 February 2002 that they will be able to file such a document no later than 10 March 2002;

NOTING FURTHER Defence Counsel’s assurances during the Status Conference that they would be in a position to nominate no later than 10 April 2002 when they will be able to file any application pursuant to Rule 115 should they decide to file one;

HEREBY ORDER that

1. No later than 10 March 2002, each Defence Counsel must file a document clearly and concisely listing each and every one of their respective grounds of appeal under the conditions laid out in the Order of 18 February 2002.
2. Defence Counsel for Mario Čerkez and Dario Kordić shall inform the court no later than 10 April 2002 when they will be in position to file their Rule 115 application should they decide to file one.
