NOTING the “Scheduling Order”, dated 28 January, ordering the Parties to file their Final Briefs no later than 25 February 2002;


NOTING the “Defence Motion for Extension of Time Limited”, dated 21 February 2002, requesting a 3-day extension of time for the filing of its Final Brief;
