TRIAL CHAMBER II of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia,

NOTING the “Scheduling Order”, dated 28 January, ordering the Parties to file their Final Briefs no later than 25 February 2002;

NOTING that a similar extension of time was granted to the Defence on 21 February 2002 to file its Final Brief;


NOTING ALSO that the Defence had no objection to the extension of time for the filing of the Prosecution’s Final Brief;
