**CONSIDERING** the importance of bringing this case on for trial as soon as possible,



**HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

- (1) The Office of the Prosecutor shall file the final version of its pre-trial brief, its list of witnesses and its list of exhibits as particularised in Rule 65 *ter* (E) of the Rules by 2 May 2002; and
- (2) The Defence for the two accused shall file their pre-trial briefs as particularised in Rule 65 *ter* (F) of the Rules by 1 September 2002.
