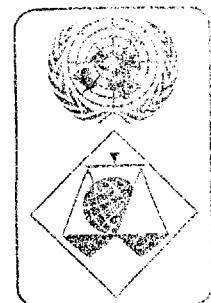

I, Amin El Mahdi, Judge at the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (hereinafter “the Tribunal”),

NOTING the Decision of 3 December 2001 in which I was designated as pre-trial Judge in this case,

PURSUANT to Rules 65 *bis* and 65 *ter* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal,

CONSIDERING that the initial appearance of the accused Paško Ljubičić took place on 30 November 2001; that the Defence for the accused filed a preliminary motion on which the Chamber has just ruled; that the proper administration of justice requires that a status conference be organised at this stage in the proceedings,

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,

ORDER that a status conference be held on Thursday 21 March 2002, at 15:00 hours, in the presence of the accused,

STATE that the parties must be ready, *inter alia*, to discuss before me all the questions pertaining to disclosure as set out in Rules 66, 67 and 68 of the Rules;
