THIS TRIAL CHAMBER, seized of the "Joint Challenge to Jurisdiction arising from the Amended Indictment", filed by the Defence on 21 February 2002 (the "Defence Motion");

NOTING the "Prosecution's Response to Joint Challenge to Jurisdiction arising from the Amended Indictment", filed by the Prosecution on 27 February March 2002 (the "Response");

CONSIDERING the oral arguments submitted by the Parties during the Status Conference held on 22 March 2002;

CONSIDERING that each Accused's case is considered separately even if in a joint trial;

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

HEREBY ORDERS that

- 1. the Parties concurrently file
- written submission on the above issue not later than 10 May 2002,
- written responses not later than 24 May 2002 and
- eventual written replies not later than 31 May 2002;
- 2. the Parties must comply, in writing such submissions, with the Practice Direction on the Length of Briefs of 19 January 2001 ("Practice Direction") as much as possible and if the Parties have a particular reason why they can not comply with this Direction, they have to apply for leave to exceed the page limits explaining the exceptional circumstances that necessitates such exception.
