THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

NOTING the previous reports of medical examination carried out on Milan Simić on 26 July 2001

(filed in English on 31 August 2001) and 4 May 2001 (filed in English on 26 June 2001),

PURSUANT TO Rule 74 bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal,

HEREBY ORDERS proprio motu that a medical examination of the accused Milan Simić shall be

carried out AND

INSTRUCTS the Registrar to entrust this task to experts whose names appear on the list previously

drawn up by the Registry and approved by the Bureau of the Tribunal.
