

HAVING BEEN DESIGNATED pre-trial Judge in the present matter by the "Order

Appointing a Pre-Trial Judge" issued by Trial Chamber II of the International Tribunal on 28

November 2001,

BEING SEISED of the "Prosecution's Request for Leave to Modify the List of Witnesses

Submitted Pursuant to Rule 65 ter (E)(ii)" ("Request"), filed on 14 March 2002, in which the

Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") seeks to add three witnesses to the witness list, of

whom one is a live witness and two are proposed Rule 92bis witnesses, while removing

certain other witnesses,

NOTING the "Orders for Filing of Motions and Related Matters," issued by the Trial

Chamber on 7 March 2002 providing that the parties have 14 days from the date of filing of a

motion in which to file responses, if any,

CONSIDERING that the Defence for Milomir Stakić did not file a response to the Request,

REMINDING the Prosecution of its disclosure obligations under Rule 66 of the Rules of

Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal,

HEREBY GRANT THE REQUEST.
