
**NOTING** the Indictment against Dragoljub Ojdanić submitted by the Prosecutor and confirmed on 29 October 2001 by me;

**NOTING** the transfer of the Dragoljub Ojdanić to the Tribunal on 25 April 2002;

**PURSUANT TO** Rules 54 and 64 of the Rules;

**HEREBY ORDERS** the detention of Dragoljub Ojdanić and enjoins the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the accused until further order.
