
NOTING the second amended indictment against Nikola Šainović confirmed by Judge May on 29 October 2001,

NOTING the transfer of Nikola Šainović to the International Tribunal on 2 May 2002,

PURSUANT TO RULES 54 and 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal,

HEREBY ORDERS the detention of Nikola Šainović and enjoins the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the accused until further order.
