I, Judge David Hunt, Judge of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991,

**NOTING** the "Decision on the Prosecutor's Request for Leave to Amend the Indictment and Issued of Warrant of Arrest and Order for Surrender", filed on 19 July 2001, whereby the amended indictment of 18 July was filed confidentially;

**BEING SEISED** of the Prosecution's *ex parte* and confidential "Request to Lift Confidentiality of Amended Indictment and Warrants of Arrest", filed on 10 May 2002, whereby the Prosecution requests that the confidentiality of the amended indictment filed on 18 July 2001 and all warrants of arrest in respect of the Momčilo Gruban which have been filed confidentially be lifted;

PURSUANT to Rules 53 and 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;

**HEREBY ORDER** that the non-disclosure orders which exist in relation to the amended indictment and all warrants of arrest in respect of the Momčilo Gruban be vacated in full, with immediate effect.
