**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("the International Tribunal"):


**PURSUANT TO RULE 64** of the Rule of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal governing detention on remand;

**NOTING** the surrender of the Accused to the International Tribunal and his transfer to the United Nations Detention Unit at The Hague on 15 May 2002;

**HEREBY ORDER** the detention on remand of Milan Martić, **INSTRUCTS** the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the accused until further order and **CONFIRMS** that 15 May 2002 shall be the date from which for any purposes it shall be recorded that the Accused has been in the custody of the International Tribunal.
