**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the International Tribunal”),

**NOTING** that the Defence for the two accused have requested oral argument on the Motion,


**NOTING** also that a status conference has been scheduled in this matter for 31 May 2002,
