I, Judge Hunt, Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;

NOTING the “Appellant Dario Kordić’s Motion for an Extension of Time within which to Submit a Book of Authorities in relation to the Supplement to his Appellant’s Brief, if one is Required”, dated 12 June 2002, whereby the Appellant seeks a seven (7) day extension of time within which to file its Book of Authorities containing the authorities cited in its “Supplement to Dario Kordić’s Appellant’s Brief”, also dated 12 June 2002 (“Supplementary Brief”);

NOTING that the Prosecution informed the Appeals Chamber orally that it did not object to the Appellant’s request;

NOTING the “Practice Direction on Procedure for the Filing of Written Submissions in Appeal Proceedings Before the International Tribunal” (IT/155/Rev 1) (the “Practice Direction”), dated 7 March 2002;

CONSIDERING that, although it does not expressly mentions supplementary briefs such as the one filed by the Appellant on 12 June 2002, the requirements of the Practice Direction also apply to such supplementary written submissions;


NOTING the volume of material which the Appellant intends to provided as authorities in relation to his Supplementary Brief;

CONSIDERING that no date has yet been set for oral arguments in this case;

CONSIDERING that the extension of time requested by the Defence, seven (7) days, is a modest one;

HEREBY GRANT the seven (7) day extension requested by the Appellant in which to file its Book of Authorities, and **ORDER** that the Book of Authorities be filed no later than 21 June 2002.
