
THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

HAVING ISSUED its “Decision on Ex Parte and Confidential Prosecution’s Motion for Witness Protection Measures” on 7 June 2002 (“Decision”), in which it ordered the unredacted disclosure of the statement of witness K20 as protected in the *Milosevic* proceedings on the basis that the protective measures initially granted by the Trial Chamber were subsequently withdrawn,

CONSIDERING that, in fact, that witness did give evidence in the *Milosevic* proceedings under the protections initially granted by the Trial Chamber,

HEREBY AMENDS that aspect of the disposition in the Decision and orders that witness K20, as identified in the *Milosevic* proceedings, shall be subject to Orders (1) (a) and (d) of the Decision
