**NOTING** that pursuant to Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules"), within one hundred and twenty days after the last Status Conference, a new Status Conference needs to be convened;

**CONSIDERING** however that the accused Dragan Nikolić has waived "his right to having a Status Conference within one hundred and twenty days of the immediately preceding Conference, and is content that any such Conference should be held at the ICTY on any convenient date in July 2002".

**HEREBY ORDER** that a Status Conference be held at 2.15 p.m. on Tuesday, 23 July 2002.
