I, Judge David Hunt, Pre-Appeal Judge,

NOTING the "Motion For Extension of Time Limit to Comply With Order Given in Decision on Prosecution Motion Requesting Order to Zoran Žigić to File Grounds of Appeal Rendered on 14 June 2002" filed by Zoran Žigić on 24 June 2002 ("Motion"), by which Zoran Žigić ("Žigić") seeks an extension of time until 5 July to comply with the "Decision on Prosecution Motion Requesting Order to Zoran Žigić to File Grounds of Appeal" issued by the Appeals Chamber on 14 June 2002 ("Decision");

CONSIDERING that the Office of Lead Counsel for Žigić did not receive a copy of the Decision until 17 June and that Lead Counsel was on leave until 22 June;

CONSIDERING FURTHER that the prosecution has informed the Appeals Chamber that it does not oppose the Motion but reserves a right to apply for an extension of time for the filing of its Consolidated Respondent's Brief should it consider the filing by Žigić on 5 July warrants the seeking of such an extension;

CONSIDERING that Rule 127(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal allows the Appeals Chamber to grant a motion to extend a time limit upon a showing of good cause and that good cause has been shown;

HEREBY ORDER the grant of an extension of time to Žigić until 5 July to comply with the Decision.
