**TRIAL CHAMBER I, SECTION A** (“the Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the Tribunal”);

**NOTING** the Chamber’s “Order on Depositions” issued on 21 June 2002;

**BEING SEISED OF** the “Accuseds [sic] Naletilić’s Submission Concerning The Order Canceling [sic] The Mostar Depositions” filed on 25 June 2002 and “Accuseds [sic] Naletilić’s Submission Concerning the Schedule for Finalizing His Case and Commencement of the Martinović Defence Case” filed 27 June 2002;

**BEING SEISED OF** the “Request for Granting of Recess Before Commencement of Defence Case Presentation” filed 27 July 2002, whereby the Defence for Martinović is requesting a 15 days recess after the defence for Naletilić has completed its case;


**NOTING** that on 27 June 2002, Counsel for the accused Naletilić orally clarified that two witnesses included in their Rule 65 *ter* filings, but left out on their latest list of witnesses, will be called to testify;

**HEREBY DECIDES** that a recess is accepted on the condition that the Defence for Naletilić has presented all live witnesses including the two witnesses mentioned above (excluding the seven witnesses proposed as video-link witnesses). In such a case, a recess will be held between the end of the presentation of the witnesses and the start of the Martinović Defence case, which is on 15 July 2002;

**ORDERS** that there will be no deposition.
