
THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED of a request from the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia dated 2 July ("Request"), in which it seeks a two week extension of time to conduct investigations in accordance with the Trial Chamber's "Order for the Immediate Cessation of Violations of Protective Measures for Witnesses" of 18 June 2002,

NOTES the arguments set out in the Request, and

HEREBY GRANTS the Request, and **ORDERS** that the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia provide the Trial Chamber with a report on the investigations and measures taken by 1 August 2002.
