I, Amin El Mahdi, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (hereinafter "the Tribunal"),

NOTING the Decision of 3 December 2001 appointing me as pre-trial Judge in this case rendered by Trial Chamber I of the Tribunal (hereinafter "the Chamber") in which I serve,

PURSUANT to Rules 54, 65 *bis* and 65 *ter* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal.

CONSIDERING that the Defence of the accused filed a motion for provisional release; that the motion was examined at the hearing on 1 July 2002; that, on that occasion, the accused was *inter alia* able to raise issues in relation to his physical and mental health and his detention conditions;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber is also seized of issues relating to the amendment of the indictment further to its Order of 7 June 2002 and the written submissions of the Prosecution and Defence of 13 and 25 June 2002 respectively;

CONSIDERING that, under these circumstances, it is in keeping with the proper administration of justice to request the parties to continue with their current efforts to identify any points of agreement or disagreement and to set the next status conference for 26 September 2002;

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,

ORDER that a status conference be held in the presence of the accused on Thursday, 26 September 2002, at a time to be set by the Registry in due course;

STATE that the parties must, in particular, be prepared to discuss before me all of the substantive issues regarding the indictment as well as those concerning disclosure between the parties as provided for under Rules 66, 67 and 68 of the Rules;
