**WARRANT OF ARREST
ORDER FOR SURRENDER**

I, JUDGE THEODOR MERON of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”);

NOTING the Indictment submitted by the Prosecutor against the accused SAVO TODOVIĆ, confirmed by Judge Lal Chand Vohrah, a Judge of the International Tribunal on 17 June 1997, a copy of which is annexed to this warrant of arrest;

NOTING Article 29 of the Statute of the International Tribunal and Rules 56, 57, 58, 59, 60 and 61 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”);


PURSUANT TO Rule 55 of the Rules;

HEREBY DIRECT and authorise the Prosecutor and/or persons or entities designated by her:

- 1) To search for, arrest, detain and surrender to the International Tribunal SAVO TODOVIĆ, son of Vladimir, born on 11 December 1952, in the village of Rijeka, permanent resident of Foča, alleged to have committed between April 1992 and October 1994 in the territory of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina the following crimes: Grave Breaches of the Geneva Conventions of 1949, Violations of the Laws or Customs of War, and Crimes against Humanity punishable under Articles 2, 3 and 5 of the Statute of the International Tribunal;
- 2) To advise the said SAVO TODOVIĆ, at the time of the arrest, in a language he understands, of his rights as set forth in Article 21 of the Statute and in Rules 42 and 43 of the Rules which are annexed hereto. The Indictment and review of the Indictment (and all other documents annexed to the present warrant of arrest) must also be brought to the attention of the accused;
- 3) To promptly notify the Registrar of the International Tribunal of the arrest of SAVO TODOVIĆ so that he may be transferred promptly to the International Tribunal pursuant to Rule 57 of the Rules, and

- 4) To report forthwith to the Registrar of the International Tribunal if they are unable to execute this warrant of arrest and to indicate the reasons for such non-execution pursuant to Rule 59(A) of the Rules.
