THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED of the "Prosecution's Submission Regarding Failure to Comply with Direction of Pre-trial Judge, Motion for Extension of Time and Motion to Amend Indictment" filed by the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") on 19 July 2002, in which the Prosecution seeks permission to amend the indictment in this case by removing the charges against the accused, Slobodan Milošević, who is currently being tried on the same charges in Case No. IT-02-54, and against the accused, Vlajko Stojlijković, now deceased, and attaching as "Attachment A" a copy of the indictment reflecting the proposed changes,

NOTING the filing by the Prosecution on 15 August 2002 of a copy of the death certificate of Vlajko Stojiljković,

NOTING that no response has been filed on behalf of any of the accused within the permitted time-frame,

NOTING that the name of the accused, Milan Milutinović, has been omitted from the cover sheet of Attachment A,

CONSIDERING that it would be in the interests of justice and of judicial economy for the indictment in this case to be amended to reflect only the charges against the remaining three accused,

CONSIDERING that the changes sought by the Prosecution are limited to those necessary to remove the charges against the accused Slobodan Milošević, and the accused, Vlajko Stojlijković,

PURSUANT TO Rule 50 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal,

HEREBY GRANTS THE MOTION and **GRANTS LEAVE TO AMEND** the Indictment as submitted as Attachment A, with the inclusion on the cover page of the name of the accused, Milan Martinović.
