
**NOTING** the temporary unavailability of Judge Fassi Fihri in the morning of Friday, 27 September 2002 due to an urgent personal matter;

**HEREBY DECIDES** to proceed in the absence of Judge Fassi Fihri under Rule 15*bis* on Friday, 27 September from 9.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. in Courtroom II.
