THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),


NOTING the hearing on 2 October 2002 at which time Biljana Plavšić pleaded guilty to Count 3 of the Amended Indictment pursuant to Rule 62 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) and that the Trial Chamber entered a finding of guilt to the charges contained in that Count,

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 100 (A)

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) The Prosecution shall file its sentencing brief (making any submissions on appropriate sentence) and statements of witnesses on which it intends to rely, by **6 November 2002**;
- (2) The Defence for Biljana Plavšić shall file its sentencing brief (making any submissions on appropriate sentence) and statements of witnesses on which it intends to rely, by **27 November 2002**;
- (3) The Trial Chamber will determine which witnesses it will hear live and which witness statements it will admit in written form and notify the parties; and
- (4) The sentencing hearing shall take place on **16 and 17 December 2002**.
