**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

**NOTING** that a new scheduling order is required to clarify the hearing schedule for the week starting 14 October 2002,

**NOTING** that the deadline for the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) to file its response to the Defence motion to acquit under Rule 98 *bis* is Wednesday 16 October 2002,

**NOTING** that, due to time limitations, the Prosecution’s response will be provided in the English language only,


**CONSIDERING** that the accused has the right to have access to the content of the Prosecution’s response in a language which he understands,

**CONSIDERING** the need to hold a Status Conference in this case to discuss various outstanding matters,

**HEREBY ORDERS** that a hearing shall be held on Wednesday 16 October commencing at 16.00 hours for the purpose of reading the Prosecution’s response into the record and providing translation into both the French and BCS languages,

**AND VARIES** the previous scheduling order, filed on 30 September 2002, to provide for a Status Conference on Thursday, 17 October commencing at 14:15 hours or, if the reading of the Prosecution’s response is not complete, immediately following the conclusion of that procedure.
