ORDER TO VACATE IN PART THE ORDER FOR NON-DISCLOSURE ISSUED ON 26 MARCH 2002

I, Judge Wolfgang Schomburg, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal");

BEING SEISED of a pleading entitled "Confidential - Motion of the Prosecution to Confirm that Indictment and Related Documents are Public Or, Alternatively, Motion to Vacate in Part the Order for Non-Disclosure Issued on 26 March 2002", dated 21 October 2002:

NOTING further that on 7 August 2002 an order for arrest and surrender, addressed to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, was issued, under seal, against **LJUBIŠA BEARA**;

CONSIDERING that the Order of 26 March 2002 was treated by the Prosecution and the Registry as an Order to prohibit disclosure; and that the arrest warrant of 7 August 2002 was issued under seal;

HEREBY ORDER that:

Previous orders in relation to the case against LJUBIŠA BEARA are vacated in part, and, to that end, the Prosecution be authorised to allow for the public disclosure of the Indictment and the warrants for arrest and surrender; and only the supporting material remain under seal until further order.
