# ORDER TO VACATE IN PART THE ORDER FOR NON-DISCLOSURE ISSUED ON 26 MARCH 2002

I, Judge Wolfgang Schomburg, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal");

**BEING SEISED** of a pleading entitled "Confidential - Motion of the Prosecution to Vacate in Part the Order for Non-Disclosure Issued on 26 March 2002", dated 21 October 2002:

**NOTING** that an order dated 26 March 2002 was issued which prohibited the disclosure of the Indictment, supporting materials, or arrest warrants until the arrest warrant was served on **VUJADIN POPOVIĆ** or unless further ordered;

**NOTING** that on 11 October 2002 an order for arrest and surrender, directed to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, has also been issued, under seal, against **VUJADIN POPOVIĆ**.

#### **HEREBY ORDER** that:

The order of 26 March 2002 against **VUJADIN POPOVIĆ** pertaining to non-disclosure of the Indictment and arrest warrants, and to non-disclosure of the order itself in the above-referenced case, is hereby vacated in part; and to that end, the Prosecution is authorised to allow for the public disclosure of the Indictment, and the warrants for arrest and surrender; and only the supporting material remain under seal until further order.
