I, Wolfgang Schomburg, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the Tribunal”) and Pre-Trial Judge in these proceedings,

NOTING that the Appeals Chamber issued a “Decision on Application by Dragan Jokić for Provisional Release” on 28 May 2002, in which the Chamber ordered the provisional release of the Accused (“Decision”);

NOTING that on 30 October a Scheduling Order was issued pursuant to Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) in which a Status Conference was ordered in the present case to be held on Wednesday 27 November 2002, from 9 a.m. till 13.45 p.m.;

NOTING that during the Status Conference, pursuant to Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules, the three accused in this case that are not on provisional release, will be present;

CONSIDERING that it is in the interests of justice that also the Accused Dragan Jokić would be present during the Status Conference. The upcoming Status Conference is of crucial importance for the further preparations for the trial and may be the last one before the trial will actually commence in spring of 2003;


PURSUANT TO Rule 54 and Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDER that

- (1) the Accused Dragan Jokić will return to the United Nations Detention Unit not later than Tuesday 26 November;
- (2) that the Accused Dragan Jokić will be present during the Status Conference of Wednesday 27 November;
- (3) that the provisional release of the Accused Dragan Jokić may continue after the Status Conference has taken place and under the same conditions as set out by the Decision of the Appeals Chamber of 28 May 2002.
