Krnojelac on 12 April 2002 and by the Prosecution on 15 April 2002, from the Judgment of

Trial Chamber II, dated 15 March 2002, in the case of Prosecutor v. Milorad Krnojelac;

NOTING that sub-Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the

International Tribunal (the "Rules") requires "the Appeals Chamber or an Appeals Chamber

Judge" to "convene a status conference, within one hundred and twenty days of the filing of

relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person";
