NOTING that the Appeals Chamber is seised of notices of appeal filed by Milorad Krnojelac on 12 April 2002 and by the Prosecution on 15 April 2002, from the Judgment of Trial Chamber II, dated 15 March 2002, in the case of *Prosecutor v. Milorad Krnojelac*;

NOTING that sub-Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (the "Rules") requires "the Appeals Chamber or an Appeals Chamber Judge" to "convene a status conference, within one hundred and twenty days of the filing of a notice of appeal and thereafter within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person";


CONSIDERING that Milorad Krnojelac is currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending the hearing of the appeal;

CONSIDERING that the last Status Conference in this case was held on 31 July 2002;

PURSUANT to sub-Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules;

ORDER that a Status Conference shall be held before me on Wednesday 27 November 2002 at 3 p.m.
