I, Judge David Hunt, a Judge of the Appeals Chamber,

**NOTING** the “Prosecution Motion for Variation of Protective Measures to Enable Filing of Public Redacted Version of Consolidated Prosecution Respondent’s Brief”, filed on 30 October 2002, whereby the prosecution moved the Appeals Chamber to rescind or vary certain protected measures ordered by the Trial Chamber in this case to the extent necessary to enable the redacted version of their brief to be made public in an intelligible format;

**NOTING** the Letter of 31 October 2002 sent to counsel for the Defence inviting them to respond to the prosecution’s motion as quickly as practicable;


**NOTING** that counsel for the Defence have not responded;
