THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),


NOTING that on 8 January 2003 Trial Chamber II of the International Tribunal ordered Biljana Plavšić to testify in the matter of *Prosecutor v. Milomir Stakić*, Case No. IT-97-24, as notified to this Trial Chamber on 9 January 2003,

CONSIDERING that this Trial Chamber considers it appropriate to allow the parties the opportunity to make submissions to the Trial Chamber on the revised circumstances and, in particular, the effect, if any, on the appropriate sentence to be imposed,

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 100 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal,

HEREBY ORDERS the parties, if they so wish and no later than Monday 20 January 2003, to file written submissions on the effect, if any, of the requirement for Biljana Plavšić to testify in other proceedings, on their previous submissions as to an appropriate sentence.
