THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the International Tribunal”);

NOTING that the Initial Appearance of Vojislav Šešelj was held on 26 February 2003;

NOTING Rule 62(iii) of the Rules and Procedure of Evidence (“the Rules”) which states that “within thirty days of the initial appearance, [the accused] will be called upon to enter a plea of guilty or not guilty on each count but that, should the accused so request, he or she may immediately enter a plea of guilty or not guilty on one or more count”;

NOTING that Vojislav Šešelj declined to enter a plea at the Initial Appearance and stated that he would enter his plea within thirty days as envisaged under Rule 62(iii);


HEREBY SCHEDULES a further appearance of the Accused for 25 March 2003, commencing at 16.30 in Courtroom I.
