THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the International Tribunal”);

PURSUANT TO Rule 65*ter* of the Rules;


HEREBY DESIGNATES provisionally Judge Wolfgang Schomburg as the pre-trial Judge in this case until further order.
