TRIAL CHAMBER I (“the Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“the Tribunal”);

NOTING the Prosecutor’s Indictment of 27th January 2003 against **Fatmir LIMAJ**, born on 4th February 1971 in Banja in the municipality of Suva Reka in Kosovo, and others (“the Indictment”);

NOTING the Decision to Confirm the Indictment and the Warrant of Arrest and Order for Surrender, issued by Judge Amin El Mahdi on 27th January 2003;

NOTING the Decision of 18th February 2003 of this Chamber to Vacate the order for Non-Disclosure of the Indictment, as amended by the Chamber’s corrigendum of 21st February 2003;

NOTING the arrest on 18th February 2003 of **Fatmir LIMAJ** and his subsequent transfer to the custody of the Tribunal on 4th March 2003;


CONSIDERING the initial appearance of **Fatmir LIMAJ** on 5th March 2003, during which he entered his pleas to the charges raised against him in the Indictment;

PURSUANT to Rule 64 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

HEREBY ORDERS the detention on remand of **Fatmir LIMAJ** and enjoins the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the accused until further order.
