
NOTING its “Decision on the Prosecutor’s Motion Seeking Leave to Amend the Amended Indictment”, issued on 28 February 2003;

NOTING that the last Status Conference for the Accused pursuant to Rule 65 bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“the Rules”) took place on 6 March 2003;

NOTING that in the course of that Status Conference the Accused was given a period of 30 days, pursuant to Rule 62 (iii), to enter a plea on the new Counts charged in the Amended Indictment;

ORDERS that the further appearance of the Accused be held on Friday 4 April 2003 in Courtroom I at 10 a.m.;
