NOTING the appeals lodged by Mirolad Krnojelac and the Prosecutor on 12 and 15 April 2002 respectively, against the Judgement rendered by Trial Chamber II on 15 March 2002 (“Appeals”);

CONSIDERING that, pursuant to Article 14(2) of the Statute of the International Tribunal, I am *ex officio* the presiding Judge in this case;


NOTING the “Order Designating a Pre-Appeal Judge” filed on 6 May 2002 assigning me as pre-appeal Judge in the present case;

CONSIDERING that Rule 65*ter* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal (“Rules”), read together with Rule 107 of the Rules, authorises the Presiding Judge of the Appeals Chamber to designate a member of the Appeals Chamber to be responsible for pre-appeal proceedings (“Pre-Appeal Judge”);

HEREBY ASSIGN, with immediate effect, Judge Mehmet Güney to replace me as Pre-Appeal Judge with responsibility for all pre-appeal proceedings in the Appeals.
