THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

BEING SEISED OF “Italy’s Request for an Extension of 30 days”, filed on 26 February 2003 in relation to the Scheduling Order issued by the Trial Chamber on 26 November 2002 (“Scheduling Order”),


NOTING that the request was filed within the original deadline and that Rule 127(A)(i) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence permits the Trial Chamber, on good cause being shown, to enlarge the time,

CONSIDERING the nature of the request by the Defence for Dragoljub Ojdanić (“Defence”) and the expressed intention of Italy to attempt to identify and produce the material sought by the Defence within that additional time,

PURSUANT TO Rule 127 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence

HEREBY GRANTS the request and sets a new deadline for the response of Italy to the Scheduling Order of 30 March 2003.
