TRIAL CHAMBER I ("the Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("the Tribunal");

BEING SEIZED OF a Motion to Amend the Indictment filed by the Prosecution on 7th March

2003 ("the Motion"), in which the Prosecution seeks leave to amend the Indictment of 27<sup>th</sup> January

2003 against Fatmir Limaj and others ("the Indictment") in order to reflect that Mr. Agim Murtezi

is no longer covered thereby;

**NOTING** that the Prosecution, after Mr. Agim Murtezi was arrested in Kosovo on 17<sup>th</sup> February

2003 and brought to the Tribunal on the following day, had been convinced that Mr. Agim Murtezi

was not the perpetrator of the crimes alleged in the Indictment;

NOTING the Chamber's Order of 28th February 2003 to Withdraw the Indictment Against Agim

Murtezi and Order for His Immediate Release, in which the Chamber ordered the Prosecution to

file an amended indictment within seven days;

NOTING that the Chamber has not received any objections from the Parties in this case against

amendment of the Indictment as proposed by the Prosecution within the time limit set out in Rule

126bis of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules");

**PURSUANT** to Rule 50(A)(i)(c) of the Rules;

**HEREBY GRANTS** the Motion.
