## ORDER SCHEDULING A STATUS CONFERENCE

I, Alphons Orie, Judge at the International Tribunal ("the Chamber") for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (the "Tribunal");

**NOTING** the decision of Trial Chamber I dated 19 June 2002 appointing me as pre-trial Judge in this case;

**NOTING** that Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules") requires the pretrial judge to organize exchanges between the parties every 120 days so as to ensure expeditious preparation for trial; to review the status of the case; and to allow the accused an opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including his mental and physical conditions;

**PURSUANT** to Rules 65 bis;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that a Status Conference will take place on Thursday 24 April 2003 in Courtroom III at 10 a.m. and that the parties be ready to discuss the status of the case.
