I, O-GON KWON, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

HAVING BEEN APPOINTED as the pre-trial Judge in this case by virtue of the Order of Trial Chamber III of the International Tribunal dated 10 December 2001,

NOTING that the pre-trial briefs of both the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) and the Defence on behalf of Sefer Halilović (“Accused”) have been filed, respectively on 17 June 2002 and 25 March 2003, and that the last Status Conference was held on 10 February 2003,

NOTING the “Prosecution’s Motion to take Deposition for use at Trial” filed by the Prosecution on 14 March 2003 (“Motion”) and that no response has been received from the Defence to the Motion,

NOTING that a number of practical issues will need to be addressed before the final determination of the Motion by the Trial Chamber, in particular, relating to the presence of the Accused at any such deposition,

PURSUANT to Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

HEREBY ORDER as follows:

- (1) in further preparation of the case for trial, a Status Conference shall be held at 15:00 hours on Thursday 22 May 2003;
- (2) the Status Conference shall include, but not be limited to, a discussion on the practical arrangements and the presence of the Accused at any such deposition that may be ordered by the Trial Chamber;
- (3) the Defence may, if it so wishes, file a response to the Motion no later than Friday 9 May 2003; and

- (4) the Registrar of the International Tribunal is invited to file written observations as to the practical implementation of the Motion and the Defence response, if any, no later than Monday 19 May 2003.
