**THIS BENCH** of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

**BEING SEIZED OF** the “General Ojdanić’s Appeal from Decision on Motion Challenging Jurisdiction and Motion for Extension of Time to File Opening Brief”, filed by the Appellant Dragoljub Ojdanić on 13 May 2003 (“Appeal and Motion for Extension of Time”);

**CONSIDERING** that the Appellant has pending before Trial Chamber III a motion requesting additional funds for his Defence, which is yet to be decided by the Trial Chamber (“Motion for Additional Funds”);

**CONSIDERING** that, by the Appeal and Motion for Extension of Time, the Appellant is seeking an extension of 15 days upon receiving the expected Trial Chamber decision, in order to file his appeal brief;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that proceedings on the interlocutory appeal be suspended until the Trial Chamber issues its decision on the Motion for Additional Funds, and that the Bench will issue its decision on the Appeal and Motion for Extension of Time in light of the Trial Chamber’s decision.
