TRIAL CHAMBER I, SECTION A (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

NOTING that due to recent developments in this case, the Trial Chamber has adjourned the trial proceedings until Monday, 23 June 2003,

NOTING that the Prosecution has indicated that it will be seeking to have two additional persons added to the witness list,

NOTING that the Trial Chamber has ordered that the Prosecution must provide copies of all statements for these additional witnesses to the Defence pursuant to Rule 66(A)(ii) twenty-five days prior to commencing the examination-in-chief of each witness,


NOTING that the Prosecution has filed a motion for leave to amend the Amended Joinder Indictment of 27 May 2002,¹

NOTING that the Trial Chamber has indicated that the Defence shall have ten days following the filing of the Motion to Amend the Indictment in which to file a response,

HEREBY ORDERS:

1. The Defence for the accused Vidoje Blagojević and Dragan Jokić shall file their responses to the Motion to Amend the Indictment by 5 June 2003;
2. The Prosecution shall file any motions to amend its witness list by 9 June 2003;
3. The Prosecution shall file a list of the next ten witnesses it intends to call *viva voce* by 13 June 2003; and
4. Trial proceedings in Case No. IT-02-60-T shall resume on 23 June 2003, with the continuation of the Prosecution’s presentation of evidence.
